Fulmore's [Spanish One-Way Dual Language Program](#) provides students the opportunity to become bilingual, biliterate, and bicultural through high-level cognitive instructional practices, which [support Austin ISD's Dual Language Mission](#). The application for middle schools is on the website:

The Fulmore MS DL program is open for students who completed a K-5 Dual Language program at an AISD elementary, or by interview & placement test. Students who **apply for a curriculum transfer** to Fulmore to attend our Dual Language Academy commit to a three-year program where one core content class per grade level is taught in Spanish, along with Spanish for Spanish Speakers (SSS), a language arts course taught in Spanish, that earns high school world language credit. Students in the DL Program have the opportunity to take Advanced Placement Spanish Level 4 in 8th grade, which earns both high school and college credit.



Transportation to and from the DL program is provided by parents. The Dual Language Academy is a separate program from the Law and Humanities Magnet School.

Students who apply and are accepted into the LHMS may also commit to continue the DL course sequence below, as applicable.
