The meeting was called to order by Jason Shafer at 3:16 pm in Library.

Citizen input: There was no citizen input at this time.

Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes: Jason Shafer asked if there were any corrections or additions to the minutes from prior meeting. There were none and the minutes were accepted as written.

Awards/Appreciations: Misti Neese – for consistently volunteering in a variety of different ways from Dillo Cards, to PTA financial assistance and many more things in the school. The CAC approved her nomination.

Coordinators Report:

Mr. Drummond presented the draft budget for Hill for the 19-20 school year. The CAC was asked if they had questions and after the discussion each member signed the Budget Review sheet, which showed they had reviewed the budget.

Mr. Drummond introduced Adrian Johnson the new Assistant Principal.

Hill Hoopla was very successful this year. The biggest changes were change of venue and online bidding software. The event was sold out and raised a lot of money to support the school through the PTA. The first annual Health Fair was a very big success. There were about 250 people who attended; there were outside vendors, give aways and general information about healthy lifestyles.

The vertical team participated in this year's last professional development day on 2/15/19; it focused on movement in the classroom training and tool kits and then the teacher did planning in the afternoon. For next year the vertical team leadership proposed 4 days for CLI professional development for teachers-September 23, 2019, October 11, 2019; January 7, 2020; and February 14, 2020.

All 3rd through 5th grade students took the MOY since the last meeting; this was the first year that they used the released STAAR test from the TEA. The teachers looked at the data in a variety of ways including scores based on

what had been taught and what they hadn't taught yet. They have identified students who could use extra support and are providing those services on a voluntary basis.

The book fair was very successful and we had Ann Grady in to talk about building resiliency for parent education. There was a lot of very positive feedback on the talk.

The CAT team met last Wednesday. It was the team's fourth meeting. They are looking at student safety, traffic patterns and viewpoints for recess now. The team is at a point where they are ready to start looking at different proposals focused on these goals and will start discussing the pros and cons of the options. There is a pre-construction meeting on April 4, 2019 where AISD construction will talk about the process, status reports etc. The AISD Futures website will be the place to get updates on the construction.

There was a parent coffee last Thursday. Kristen Ashy gave an update on the Health Education Curriculum and Sammi Harrision talked about the Anderson High School IB program. The Heritage Fashion Show will be March 28th. Kinder Roundup is April 2nd. Dill Camp is still registering for the camps that aren't full yet.
