

Getting Your Kids To School



Some safe ways to get your kids to school are to use the bus, car line, bike, or walking school bus. All of these reduce automobile traffic.

Bus: Have your children get on the morning bus, and then move on with your day. No fuss and no traffic.

Car line: A convenient way to drop off your children. The school car line wraps around Tallwood to Cima Serena to Robbie. Drop off is near the school entrance. All drop-off points and entrances monitored by school staff.

Walking School Bus: Drop off your children at Hillcrest Baptist Church any time by 7:27AM to take advantage of this supervised and super-fun way for your kids to get to school.

Dillos Drive Smart Guidelines



Arrive early.

This makes a huge difference in how much traffic is on the road.



Follow posted traffic and parking signs.

No parking, stopping, or standing is permitted within 30 feet of a street corner. This applies to all corners around Hill.



Keep those driveways clear.

Our school neighbors need to get to work, too.



Park on the right side of the road.

Parking on the same side as the direction of traffic makes leaving more orderly and safe, and it's the law.



Don't make U-turns.

This in particular causes unsafe conditions and slows down traffic flow.



Drive slowly.

Keep it under 20mph in the school zone.



Drop off in the car line only.

Dropping off your children on the side of the street violates parking laws (no stopping or standing) and creates an unsafe situation for your children.

We all struggle with getting kids to move in the morning, but a tardy slip is a much better option than breaking laws and endangering children.
