Hill Web Team (will need 1 co-chair) – This committee runs and supports hillelementary.com, including school updates (Teachers, Staff, Events, lunch menus, daily schedules) and also assists any PTA committees throughout the year (Open House, Marketplace, Hill Hoopla tickets, Carnival ticket sales, etc). You don't have to be a web developer to participate! Word Press and Mailchimp skills are definitely a plus!

Veteran's Day Assembly (will need 1 chair) – We need a volunteer to coordinate Hill's annual Veteran's Day assembly and picture Honor Wall in November.

Book Fair (will need 1 chair and 2 co-chairs) – We need a chair and committee members to organize this week-long event and family night. Planning for this begins in late fall with the heaviest commitment for the few weeks surrounding the book fair. The week of the book fair is usually a full week commitment.

Dillo Cards (will need 1 co-chair) – This committee organizes monthly pre-paid cards from stores like HEB, Randalls, Whole Foods, and Starbucks to be sent to your home, plus offers special gift cards for the holidays. All purchases directly benefit Hill! Most of the work can be done from home.

Lost & Found (will need 1 co-chair) - Organize lost items from the playground. Advertise lost items in the Dillo Details weekly.

Teacher Workroom (will need 1 chair & several volunteers) - If you have a few free minutes to spend at school, volunteer to be on the Workroom committee. You'll assist teachers with copying, laminating, class projects, and more. Schedules are flexible and can be scheduled at your convenience.

Nat'l Walk to School (will need 1 chair) - Organize this annual outdoor event. Walk to School Day is October 6.

Dillo Dash (will need 1 chair and 1 co-chair) - Organize this annual outdoor event. Dillo Dash is mid-November.

Blood Drive (will need 1 chair) - Organize and coordinate two blood drives for the Hill community.

Int'l Reading Week (will need 1 chair) - Coordinate volunteers to read books to classes in various languages during the springtime International Reading Week. This is

a virtual position and the majority of the work is done over just a few weeks in the spring.

Math Pentathlon (will need 1 chair and 1 co-chair) - This after-school program that practices math skills and logical thinking needs parent volunteers to help with instruction and monitor the games. The commitment is weekly and requires the chair to organize parent volunteers, register students for the tournament, and coordinate t-shirt and coordinate t-shirt for tournament participants and volunteers.

New Parent Coordinator (will need 1 co-chair) - This committee is great for parents who have incoming Kindergartners. Volunteers meet with other new parents and give them tours of the school.

Parent Education (will need 1 chair) - Know a hot topic you would love to share with the community? Arrange guest speakers to speak on a topic beneficial to the Hill Community. This can primarily be done from home and the speaker event typically occurs at the January PTA meeting.

Reflections (will need 1 chair) - We are looking for volunteers to encourage and celebrate participation in the arts through the PTA Reflections program. Students are recognized at the Local (Hill), Council (AISD), State, and National PTA levels.

Literacy Library (will need 1 co-chair) - This small library is for teacher use only as students are learning to read at various levels. Volunteers are needed to check books in/out and assist with occasional audits.

Math Buddies (will need 1 chair) - This committee pairs adult volunteers with students needing assistance in math. Mentors meet with the same student once a week for 30 minutes.

Heritage Fashion Show (will need 1 chair) - Organize the annual Heritage Cultural Fashion Show in the Spring to celebrate our school's diverse cultures and nations.
